Introduction

The Dubai Rally was first held in 1970, establishing itself as one of the oldest and most prestigious motorsport events in the region. Over the decades, it has built a strong legacy, attracting world class competitors and showcasing Dubai's passion for motorsport.

In 2016, the rally embraced a new chapter, transforming into an offroad "Baja" format to align with the rapid evolution of car and motorcycle racing. Baja is one of the toughest offroad motorsport type of event. Race happens between cars, motorbikes and side-by-side (buggies) This shift not only modernized the event but also reinforced its status as a key round of the FIA World Cup for Cross-Country Bajas, ensuring Dubai remains at the forefront of international rallying.

The rally is held annually under the generous patronage of His Highness Sheikh Hamdan bin Mohammed Al Maktoum, Crown Prince of Dubai, Deputy Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, and Chairman of the Executive Council of the Emirate of Dubai.

In 2024, the rally was inaugurated by His Highness Sheikh Mansoor bin Mohammed Al Maktoum, Chairman of the Dubai Sports Council, alongside His Excellency Mohammed Ben Sulayem, President of the Fédération Internationale de l'Automobile (FIA). The event was also attended by numerous VIPs, including His Excellency Omar Al Futtaim.

For 2025, the event will once again return to the now popular Dubai Festival City, where the event will be based in the Dubai Festival City mall. This prime location offers all the event attendees a conveniet location within the city of Dubai while still allowing easy access to the remarkable Al Qudra desert nearby.






2025 Dubai International Baja – Service Park Location <u>HERE</u>

For Competitors to be eligible for the UAE Entry rates, the Competitor must have UAE nationality or hold a current UAE Residence Visa and a FIA/FIM License issued by EMSO.

Any entry fees paid at Administrative checks will increase by 10% over the fee rate they have confirmed.







Entry Fees

THE REGISTRATION FEE INCLUDES:

- Rental of safety equipment (SPORTTRAXX). Deposit €250 due at documentation.

- Participation in the event (administrative and scrutineering, prologue and 2 days of racing) with sport organization, logistics and organization documents,
- Competitors' visa (if not delivered at airport) registered before the earlier bird rate cutoff date.
- Organizer's Public liability insurance,
- Medical and repatriation insurance for competitors and overseas assistance personnel registered with the event,
- Licensed Medical staff.
- Medical resources: Ambulances and medical helicopters, all equipped with first aid and rescue equipment on stages
- Medical Center at the Service Park...
- Provision of energy in the bivouac only for mechanical assistance. (No energy or water will be provided for motorhomes or camping vehicles.)

According to the FIA and FIM regulations the registration of the Services Crews and Service Vehicle is COMPULSORY.

Each Service Crew member should arrange their own travel insurance during their stay in UAE.







Safety and Tracking Equipment

Tracking and Timing, following a successful usage in previous years, the DIB will again use timing and tracking system provided by rally specialists Sporttraxx. The system will utilize GSM based tracking using 4G + 2G technology.

No additional brackets or cables need to be purchased for this system and you will receive the equipment as you go through scrutineering.

For motorcyclists, the main device will be fixed on the bike and the small wireless remote control will be carried on their person.

For cars it will be fixed to the vehicles roll cage and the remote control will be accessible on the dashboard. No external antenna is required. The internal batteries last for the entire duration of the event. The cost of the Tracking and Timing system has been integrated into the Entry Fee.

Deposit

There will be a <u>€250 deposit</u> taken at event Administrative checks on for the safe return of the Tracking and Timing Equipment.

This deposit will be refunded at the finish of the event by the account department (Administrative room) on presentation of the Sporttraxx ID Card that proves the material has been returned to Sporttraxx.

If the Competitor does not collect the deposit, it will be sent by bank transfer maximum one month after the event. The expenses of the bank transfer will be paid by the Competitor.











Navigation Equipment

Navigation and Safety equipment

The DIB will continue working with **ERTF** to provide navigation and sentinel for competitors.

The cost of these devices is **NOT** included in the Entry Fee and must be paid directly to ERTF

ERTF will request a deposit of €1700 for the material at Administrative checks.

The electronic road book will be used for this rally for both FIA Auto and all FIM competitors.

Repatriation and Medical Insurance

An accident & Sickness Emergency Medical and Repatriation expense is included in the entry fee to a level of AED 626,000 (\$170,000 / EUR 159,000).

The repatriation insurance for the Service Crews is not included in the entry fees. It is each team or service crew member's responsibility

to purchase the service crew package to ensure they have insurance coverage.

UAE Rules concerning medical expenses and hospitalization

It is important for all Competitors to fully understand the situation with regards to Medical expenses according to the UAE Rules.

In the event that "you" the registered Competitor has an accident during the event and requires medical attention in a hospital then the following procedure needs to be followed:

- On release from Hospital any Medical costs needs to be settled by you or third party before leaving the hospital.
- In case of accident, a claim form will be sent to you or third party by email, which needs to be completed along with the Hospital report and receipt.
- Once received and verified, then these documents are forwarded onto our Insurance Company for review and process.
- · Please note than there is an excess applicable to all insurance claims.

By the fact to sign your entry form, you fully understand the above, and the medical costs must be settled before leaving the hospital.

Insurance (civil liability)

Civil Liability for Competitors and Service Crews

The entry fee includes cover for civil liability of the competitor from the Start of Administrative Checks until retirement/exclusion, the limit for protests and appeals, post event Scrutineering, so from 20th to 23rd of November, 2025.

This cover provides for a maximum liability, in respect of any one claim or series of claims resulting from one accident, of AED 38,888,000 (USD 10,581,800. Damages to rally and/or service cars as well as the liability of a crew member towards other crew members are not covered by the insurance provided by the organizers.

Civil Liability for Service Vehicles

Only Overseas Competitive vehicles (non GCC) are covered for Civil Liability towards Third Parties (Road Legal), from 19th – 24th of November 2025. Outside of these dates, the owner of the vehicles needs to have his proper vehicle insurance valid in UAE. All UAE or GCC registered cars must show proof of their own vehicle Civil Liability insurance policy.

Pertinent Insurance Related Requirements:

The Organiser is able to ensure such vehicles for the duration of the event, provided that said vehicle/are registered with the organisation utilising the official event online entry system at https://registration.emso.ae/ and also submitting a clearly scanned colour copy of the vehicle registration certificate (all pages/both sides) and temporary import documents. Competitors are furthermore reminded that UAE Rental Vehicles and all insurance related obligations are the sole responsibility of the competitor.



Accommodation

There are many hotel options with 5-10mins of the service park in four different areas listed below.

<u>Dubai Festival City</u> hosts several hotels that will be just minutes to the Biyouac.

<u>Dubai Airport</u> area offer hotels close to DXB airport and within 10 mins of the Bivouac.

<u>Al Jaddaf</u> area offers hotels in a wide range to fit most budgets from 3 to 5 stars.

<u>Dubai Creek Harbor</u> offers beautiful waterfront hotels in a new and exciting area of the city.



UAE Travel Visa

For all persons coming to the United Arab Emirates to attend the event, most countries will be able to get a VISA on arrival. We would encourage all participants to check their Visa requirements to enter the UAE at the below link minimum 2 weeks before they travel.




